Friday Free for All Radio Net - Script

This is: **your call sign phonetically and strait**

Does anyone need to use this frequency before I call the **Friday Free for All Net?**

(If someone is on the frequency, let them know the net is about to start and ask if they could move their QSO or join the net if they like.)

Again this is **your call sign**, and I will be Net Control for today's Net on **(DATE)**. My name is **(your name)**, and my QTH is **(your location, in general, is fine)**.

This is an informal / general Net for the purpose of “Rag Chew”, “Trader’s / Swop Net”, “Technical Net”, and any other purpose that we can help each other out. This Net meets here each Friday evening at 8:30 PM ET. And while it is a Directed Net, we will keep it informal and enjoyable; however, all standard net procedures will be followed.

We would like to thank the repeater owner, Sumter County Emergency Management, for allowing us the opportunity to use this repeater for this net.

So let's get started; please give your call sign, your QTH, and what section of the net you are interested in; “Trader’s Net,” “Technical Net,” “Informational Net,” or “Rag Chew.” Please speak slowly, and I will acknowledge each call and then ask for the next one. Please be patient, and we will get everyone logged in. **(Round one is for check-ins.)**

Once you have all the initial check-ins, you can start with round two, “Trader’s Net,” with round three; “Technical Net,” then with round four; “Informational Net,” then round five, with “Rag Chew” taking it out to closing of the net.

As the Net is winding down, ask if there is anyone who needs anything further or if there is anything the Net can do for anyone. **(If so, deal with whatever it is; however, it needs to be dealt with.)**

I would like to thank everyone for joining the Net tonight and invite you back again next Friday evening at 8:30 PM for another wonderful Net. Good night and have a great weekend.
